SAN FRANCISCO (May 2, 2022)—Indie tech-book publisher No Starch Press just announced a three-week partnership with [Humble Bundle](#) that lets customers pay what they want for popular, DRM-free ebook titles, while donating to charity. The deal builds upon the bookseller's hugely popular collaboration with the digital gaming retailer which, to date, has raised over \$2.2 million for various nonprofit organizations.

The "[Python, by No Starch Press](#)" bundle runs now through May 23rd and benefits the Python Software Foundation—a nonprofit devoted to advancing the Python programming language—as well as [Hacker Initiative](#), a public 501(c)(3) organization for hackers, created by NSP founder Bill Pollock.

It's not the first time No Starch Press has enabled readers to help fund the PSF via Humble Bundle. "As the world's leading publisher of Python books, we always welcome the chance to directly support the PSF's work," Pollock said. "Their efforts protecting the language's IP rights, managing codebase contributions, and providing a homebase for the global Python community benefit all of us."

Loren Crary, PSF's Director of Resource Development, expressed gratitude for the nonprofit's inclusion in the deal. "We love that this No Starch Press partnership is a way for people to build or begin their Python education—and support the PSF at the same time," she said. Charitable contributions from the Humble Bundle, she added, will help the Foundation facilitate Python events and projects that "empower Pythonistas around the world."

The promotion's pay-what-you-want model means customers choose a pricing tier for up to 18 ebooks, then decide how much of their purchase goes to charity. With a total market value of \$663, the "[Python, by No Starch Press](#)" bundle features international bestsellers like *Python Crash Course*, picks like *Serious Python* for advanced programmers, and introductions to new disciplines, such as *Practical Deep Learning*.
