### **No Starch Press Partners with Humble Bundle to Benefit EFF and Let's Encrypt** *Fundraising collaboration offers pay-what-you-want deal to support charities*



**SAN FRANCISCO (Sept. 12, 2022)**—Indie tech-book publisher No Starch Press has announced a new partnership with Humble Bundle that lets customers pay what they want for a curated ebook collection, while making a charitable donation. The three-week online deal builds upon the business pair's popular past collaborations, which have raised over \$2.2 million for various nonprofit organizations to date.

The "[Linux by No Starch Press](#)" bundle runs through October 3rd, and benefits the Electronic Frontier Foundation (EFF)—the leading nonprofit defending online privacy—and Let's Encrypt, a free SSL certificate authority. This promotion is dedicated to the memory of beloved technologist Peter Eckersley, who died in early September. Eckersley served as Chief Computer Scientist at EFF, and co-founded Let's Encrypt in order to make the internet a safer, more secure place for everyone.

Readers pick from a pricing tier between \$1 and \$40 for up to 21 DRM-free titles, allocating a portion of their payment to the publisher's chosen charities. "EFF is grateful to No Starch Press and the open-source software community for their years of support for our work. They help make the movement for digital privacy, free speech, and open-access possible," said EFF legal director Corynne McSherry.
