- Java, available for free from <http://www.java.com/en/download/>
- The book's accompanying setup folder, available for free from <https://www.nostarch.com/pythonwithminecraft/> (includes the Python Minecraft API and Spigot server)

### IF YOU'RE USING OS X 10.10 OR LATER
